### The Heart of a Pioneer Woman: Heirloom Seed Exchange

#### Heirloom Seed Exchange Instructions:

- ✓ Please package personally collected heirloom vegetable or flower seeds in a labeled packet or small baggie. If the heirloom seed is a purchased seed, you do not need to re-package it.
- ✓ Each packet should contain 25-35 seeds and be labeled with crop type, variety name and the date of seed harvest. Details about the seed and planting instructions are optional but nice to have.

Labeling

Example:

<p><b>Crop Type:</b> Broccoli <b>Variety:</b> Waltham 29 <b>Date Harvested:</b> November 2015</p>

- ✓ Please only bring viable seed that is less than 4 years old.
- ✓ You may bring hybrid seed that is a purchased seed and is labeled according to the labeling instructions. Please clearly identify hybrid seed by writing on the label or packet.
- ✓ Please do not bring any genetically modified seed (GMO) to share at the exchange.

**If you do not have any seed to share, please do not hesitate to attend the seed exchange; sometimes there is extra seed available afterward to share with those who are new to seed-saving.**
