

## **Riverside Bible Camp: Packing List/Additional Information**

### **Arrival/Departure:**

Arrival/Check-in takes place from 3:30 - 5:00 PM on the first day of camp. Please plan to arrive when check-in begins as you will be responsible to supervise your children until that time.

Departure/Check-out takes place at 11:00 AM on the last day of camp. Please plan to check-out your child before leaving the camp grounds.

### **Packing Information:**

Riverside Bible Camp has chosen to maintain a clothing standard to help campers dress modestly; therefore, as you pack for your summer camp experience, we would ask the following of our campers:

Do not bring clothing with questionable words or graphics.

Shirt should cover the stomach and not be low cut or bare back. Tops for girls should have 1" straps. We prefer that shorts are relaxed and at least reach to the thumbnails when arms are hanging at the camper's side. Skirts should be longer.

Guys' swimsuits must be trunk-style; girls' suits are to be one piece. Swimwear is only to be worn at the swim area (we ask that your child wears a shirt and shorts over swimsuits to and from the waterfront). Shoes must also be worn to and from the waterfront.

All clothing, luggage and personal items should be labeled with camper name.

Do not bring food, candy or beverages.

Do not bring any firearms, knives, fireworks, personal entertainment equipment (electronic games, cell phones, pagers, radios, DVD players, iPods, MP3 players, etc.).

Do not bring any books other than Bible study reading materials.

### **Additional Packing Information:**

Bible/Pencil/Notebook/Materials for writing home

Sleeping bag and/or bedding and a pillow

Towel/Washcloth

Jacket

Camp clothes (outdoor clothes you are able to get dirty/long pants)

One set of clothes that you are ok with getting muddy

Closed toe shoes (tennis shoes for recreation)

Toothbrush/Toothpaste/Shampoo/Soap/Deodorant

Flashlight/Raincoat/Insect Repellent

Optional - Spending money (the average amount for Adventure Camp is \$1.00 for snacks as the book store is open when parents pick up their children the last day of camp. The average amount for Junior, Junior High, and Senior High Camp is \$20.00 - \$40.00). Spending accounts are set up at the time of check-in so that campers do not have to carry cash.

Optional - Camera

**Please keep in mind that...**

Campers are expected to follow the camp schedule.

Personal conduct will be compatible with the Christian ideals of the camp which excludes the use of tobacco, drugs and alcohol.

No one may leave the camp early except by permission of the director.

Sickness or injury must be reported immediately to the camp nurse.

The camp management reserves the right to send anyone home for misconduct.

**Medications**

Medications must be in the original prescription bottle showing the camper's name and non-expired date. Please place medications in a plastic ziploc bag with the camper's name on the bag.

The health section must be completed and SIGNED by a parent/legal guardian. Please fill out the form in its entirety. In the event you are unreachable during your child's visit to camp, please fill out the Emergency Contact information so that we will be able to locate you.

Riverside Bible Camp does not provide health or accident insurance for campers; all expenses incurred are the responsibility of the camper's family. Parents, you can be assured that the best available care will be given your child if a need arises.

### **Cancellations**

If you need to cancel your registration, please notify us as soon as possible. Your courtesy may help another camper on the waiting list be able to attend camp. As indicated on the brochure, registration deposits are not refundable or transferable.

### **Cabin Requests**

Cabin assignments are completed one week prior to your child's week at camp. If you would like, you may request cabin buddies on the registration form. A buddy group consists of a camper and one or two other campers. Cabin buddies must request each other for the request to be considered. Please contact the camp for any changes or additions. As cabin assignments have already been completed, cabin requests will not be accepted at the time of check-in.
