

Riverside Bible Camp: Family Camp - Packing List/Additional Information

Arrival/Departure:

Arrival/Check-in takes place from 4:00 - 5:30 PM on Friday. Please plan to check-in during that time frame unless you have registered to check-in later that evening. Our first gathering will be at 5:30pm followed by dinner together at 6pm.

Departure/Check-out takes place at 1:00 PM on Sunday.

Packing Information:

Riverside Bible Camp has chosen to maintain a modest clothing standard; therefore, as you pack for camp, we would ask the following of our campers:

Do not bring clothing with questionable words or graphics.

Shirt should cover the stomach and not be low cut or bare back. Tops for girls should have 1" straps. We prefer that shorts/skirts are relaxed and at least reach to the thumbnails when arms are hanging at the camper's side.

Guys' swimsuits must be trunk-style; girls' suits are to be one piece. Swimwear is only to be worn at the swim area (please wear a shirt and shorts over swimsuits to and from the waterfront). Shoes must also be worn to and from the waterfront.

Do not bring any firearms, knives, fireworks. We prefer that children do not use personal entertainment equipment during camp (electronic games, cell phones, pagers, radios, DVD players, iPods, MP3 players, etc.).

Additional Packing Information:

Bible/Pencil/Notebook

Sleeping bag and/or bedding and a pillow

Towel/Washcloth

Sweatshirt/Jacket

Camp clothes (outdoor clothes you are able to get dirty/long pants)

Closed toe shoes (tennis shoes for farm visit/archery/recreation)

Toothbrush/Toothpaste/Shampoo/Soap/Deodorant

Flashlight

Insect Repellent

Rain Gear – raincoat or umbrella

Optional - Spending money for the camp store and/or canteen snacks

Optional - Camera

Please keep in mind that...

Families are expected to follow the camp schedule.

Personal conduct will be compatible with the Christian ideals of the camp which excludes the use of tobacco, drugs and alcohol.

No one should leave the camp during the weekend unless it is part of a scheduled activity or the camp director has been informed of the departure.

Sickness or injury must be reported immediately to the camp nurse.

The camp management reserves the right to send anyone home for misconduct.

Medications

Since families are staying together, medications are not turned in to the camp nurse but are kept by the parents.

Riverside Bible Camp does not provide health or accident insurance for campers; all expenses incurred are the responsibility of the camper's family.

Cancellations

If you need to cancel your registration, please notify us as soon as possible. Your courtesy may help another family on the waiting list be able to attend camp. Registration deposits are not refundable or transferable.

Cabin Requests

Cabin assignments are completed one week prior to the camp. Cabin requests may be made for specific cabins or rooms; however, cabins or rooms are assigned based on the size of the family and/or any physical needs of campers. As cabin assignments have already been completed, cabin requests will not be accepted at the time of check-in.
