

RSI Rules

1. Stay within camp boundaries
2. No PDA. Behave like Christian young people. If you wouldn't do it in church, then don't do it here. Side hugs to say hello and goodbye, high fives, and fist bumps are acceptable.
3. Stay within the lighted areas
4. Rule of 3 or 5. Stay in groups of odd numbers. This is to protect everyone involved from potentially harmful situations, accusations, and temptation.
5. You are not allowed to start a relationship with a fellow RSler, Camper, or LIFTer, during the summer. If a romantic relationship is started, you may lose your ability to serve with one another.
6. Do not bully
7. Do not use sarcasm towards another person
8. Music may only be played at appropriate times by a staff member.
9. Only Christian music may be played (this means by artists who are declared Christians, not just music that is seen as "appropriate".)
10. No girls in guys' cabins and no guys in girls' cabins
11. Campers are not allowed in RSI dorms.
12. RSlers are not allowed in camper cabins unless it is for a specific assigned task.
13. No open food or drink in cabins. This will attract bugs and mice.
14. No phone policy – you must turn your phone in at the staff meeting or your parents say that your phone is with them.
15. No electronic devices- phones without data, laptops, and tablets are not permitted to be used during camp unless otherwise discussed.
16. You must turn in your car keys at the start of camp.
17. You cannot leave camp unless you have express permission.
18. No sharing hammocks or blankets.
